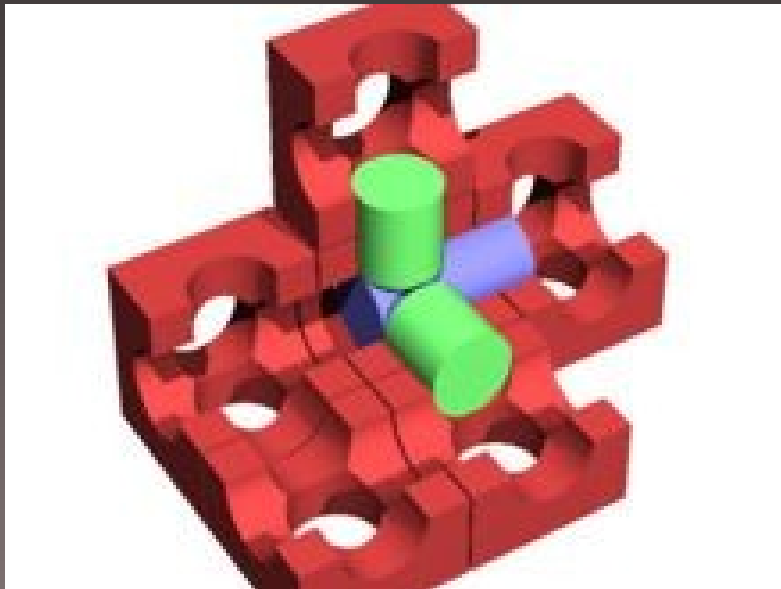




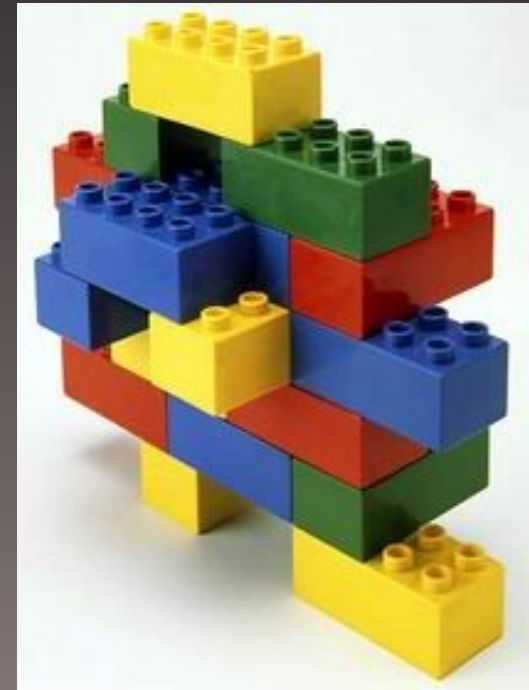
Architecture
